



GLP-1 Drugs for **Weight Loss** and **Diabetes**

While glucagon-like peptide-1 (GLP-1) drugs were traditionally used to treat diabetes, they are now in demand for weight loss. They can also be used to prevent heart attacks or strokes for adults with heart disease.



A recent KFF poll found that 12% of adults have taken a GLP-1 drug at some point, including 6% who are currently taking such a drug.

With a growing list of available GLP-1s, it can be confusing to understand their differ- ences. The following charts break down these drugs by active ingredients, brand names and approved uses of popular GLP-1 medications.

Active Ingredient: Semaglutide

Semaglutide mimics the GLP-1 hormone, which is released in the gut when eating. GLP-1 prompts the body to produce more insulin, reducing blood sugar.

Active Ingredient: Liraglutide

Liraglutide is similar to semaglutide in that it mimics GLP-1.

These are just a few of the most popular active ingredients and brand names. Other GLP-1s available on the market include dulaglutide, exenatide, liraglutide and lixisenatide.

Active Ingredient: Tirzepatide

While semaglutide and liraglutide mimic one hormone, **tirzepatide** mimics two. Tirzepatide is a dual glucose-dependent insulinotropic polypeptide (GIP)/GLP-1 receptor agonist. GIP also stimulates meal-time insulin secretion.

All forms and strengths of these drugs are meant to be used as long-term treatments for their approved uses. Keep in mind that diet and exercise changes are often combined with these medications to enhance their health benefits.
